

Pre-application workshop checklist

For all questions, “you and your” refers to the student completing the application.

What to bring to the workshop:

- 1. Social Security number** — Be sure to know your Social Security number, as you will need it to submit your application. If you don't know yours or don't have it, don't worry, we will help you complete your next steps without it.
- 2. Application fee** — To complete the ASU application, you must pay the application fee or indicate your eligibility for a waiver.
- 3. Driver license** — If you have a driver license, great, bring it. If not, that's okay.
- 4. Unofficial transcript** — To self-report your grades, you will need an unofficial transcript for reference. If you do not self-report your grades, you will need to send an official transcript to ASU. Self-reporting your grades allows your application to be processed faster.
- 5. Parent or guardian contact information** — It is helpful if you can provide the following information about your parent(s) or guardian(s) on the application:
 - a. First and last name.
 - b. Relation to you.
 - c. Living or not living.
 - d. Phone.
 - e. Email.
 - f. Highest education completed.
 - g. Did your parent or guardian attend ASU?

For Arizona residents only:

What to find out from your parents or guardians before the workshop:

Were you claimed as a dependent for income tax purposes by a parent or legal guardian in 2018 or 2019?

Did you or will you file state taxes for the 2019 tax year?

○ If you select “yes”, you will be expected to produce W-2 forms if you submit a FAFSA to ASU.

In which state do your parent(s) or legal guardian(s) currently live?

If your parent(s) or legal guardian(s) currently live in Arizona, when did they begin living in Arizona?

Did or will your parent(s) or legal guardian(s) file state income tax returns for the 2019 tax year?

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For Arizona residents only:

What to find out from your parents or guardians before the workshop cont'd:

Do you own or operate a vehicle registered in the state of Arizona?

If yes, what year and month was it first registered?

In which state did or will your parent(s) or legal guardian(s) file state income taxes for 2019?

Does either parent or legal guardian have a valid Arizona driver's license?

Is either parent or legal guardian currently employed in Arizona?

This question is asking if parents pay state taxes based on their employment status.

What to review before the application workshop:

- **asu.edu/degrees** — You will be required to select a degree for admission to ASU. If you are unsure of your degree program of interest, or would like to know more about degree options at ASU, we suggest you [explore ASU's Degree Search](#) prior to the application workshop.
